TUITION AND FEES

A deposit of one month's tuition is due on May 15, 2024. For your convenience, we will accept 9 additional payments to be set up in the synagogue office using a credit card. The first payment will be due on July 5, 2024. Subsequent payments will be charged on or around the 5th of each month. Checks are also accepted.

Families who are not members of Congregation Sha'are Shalom must also pay a \$150.00 Building Fund Fee per family. It is due along with the first tuition payment. Members must be in good standing to qualify for member rates. A 5% discount is available for the tuition of second and subsequent children.

A \$150 Registration Fee per child must be included with the application. This fee is non-refundable unless the school is unable to enroll your child by September 2024. Please make your check out to Congregation Sha'are Shalom.

3 Days: W/Th/F 9 am to 12 noon (no lunch)

3 Days: W/Th/F 9 am to 1 pm

This class is open to children two years old on or before September 30, 2024.
